Falcon jet takes Honeywell Ovation Select, SATCOM and flight management upgrade



Overview

A Falcon 900B belonging to a national air force in the Far East needed a major upgrade to enable senior government ministers and air force officers to stay in constant contact with colleagues and officials on the ground.

They also needed high quality systems and equipment in the cabin, to conduct business as usual while en route and to enable passengers to relax and arrive at their destination rested, refreshed and ready to go.

RUAG Aviation of Switzerland was appointed to lead the project and specified Honeywell's Ovation Select cabin management and SATCOM systems, together with an upgrade to the Falcon's flight management system.

Working in close partnership, the RUAG and Honeywell team applied decades of experience and expertise to successfully integrate these new systems and technologies into the ageing Falcon, delivering an outstanding working travelling environment for both passengers and crew.

RUAG Aviation is a leading supplier, support provider and integrator of systems and components for the civil and military aviation industry. Ovation Select delivers high speed access to email and internet, videoconferencing and telephone services come as standard as do Blu-ray players, crisp surround-sound audio and high definition monitors. The system features the latest in fully integrated components and can accommodate anything from USB drives and laptop computers to HD gaming machines and devices, with the content shared throughout the cabin.

Passengers can control their environment too from the comfort of their seats, with all of the cabin's environmental controls, such as lighting and temperature, easily adjustable.

Ovation Select is robust too with many elements that make maintenance and fine-tuning very straightforward. Additional preparatory work was required on the aircraft to enable the new systems to be successfully fitted and integrated with existing systems, cabling and hardware, requiring perseverance, ingenuity and teamwork.
